Reference is invited to the Hon,ble Prime Minister's launch of MSME Support & Outreach Program on 02.11.2018 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi, wherein Hon'ble Prime Minister has unveiled 12 key initiatives for MSMEs (copy enclosed) including -

"The Prime Minister announced that all companies with a turnover more than Rs. 500 crore, must now compulsorily be brought on the Trade Receivables e-Discounting System (TReDS). He said that joining this portal will enable entrepreneurs to access credit from banks, based on their upcoming receivables. This will resolve their problems of cash cycle."

In this connection, it may be noted that M/o MSME has already issued two notifications dated 02.11.2018 [copies attached S.O.5621(E) & S.O.5622(E)] - to provide further ease of doing business, in exercise of powers conferred by section 9 of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006(27 of 2006).



Hon'ble Prime Minister's 12 key announcements on 02.11.2018 regarding Support and Outreach Initiatives for MSME Sector

S. No.	Announcement
I	II
1	Launch of 59 minute loan portal to enable easy access to credit for MSMEs. In-principle approval of loans upto Rs. 1 crore through the portal. Portal link through GST portal.
2	(i) 2% interest subvention for all GST registered MSMEs, on fresh or incremental loans. (ii) Increase in interest rebate from 3% to 5% for exporters who receive loans in the pre-shipment and post-shipment period.
3	Companies with turnover more than Rs. 500 crore to be compulsorily brought on the Trade Receivables e-Discounting System (TReDS) to enable entrepreneurs to access credit, based on upcoming receivables.
4	Central Public Sector Undertaking (CPSUs) units to make mandatory procurement of 25% instead of 20% from MSEs.
5	CPSUs to make mandatory procurement of 3% from Women Entrepreneurs out of 25% mandatory procurement.
6	CPSUs to compulsorily be part of Public Procurement Portal GeM- Government e-Marketplace. CPSUs to get their vendors registered on GeM portal.
7	20 Hubs and 100 Spokes in the form of Tool Rooms for Technological Upgradation to be established across the country with a fund allotment of Rs. 6000 crore.
8	Clusters for Pharma MSMEs to be supported with 70% Govt. of India assistance.
9	Only one annual return to be filed for 8 Labour laws and 10 Union regulations to simplify Government procedures.
10	Computerized random allotment for visits to firms by Inspectors to simplify Government procedures.
11	Environment Clearance and Consent to establish unit to be merged into a single consent. Return to be accepted on the basis of Self-Certification.
12	Ordinance has been promulgated to enable entrepreneurs to correct the minor violations under the Companies Act through simple procedures rather than to approach Courts.

का.आ. 5621(अ).—केंद्रीय सरकार, सूक्ष्म, लघु और मध्यम उद्यम विकास अधिनियम, 2006 (2006 का 27) की धारा 9 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए यह अनुदेश जारी करती है कि कंपनी अधिनियम, 2013 (2013 का 18) के अंतर्गत पंजीकृत सभी कंपनियों, जिनका कारोबार (टर्नओवर) 500 करोड़ रुपये (पांच सौ करोड़ रुपये) से अधिक है और सभी केंद्रीय सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र के उद्यम, जो भारतीय रिजर्व बैंक की अधिसूचना के अनुसार स्थापित हैं, को ट्रेड रिसीवेबल डिस्काउंटिंग सिस्टम प्लेटफार्म पर रखना होगा। प्रत्येक राज्य में कंपनियों के रजिस्ट्रार अपनी अधिकारिता के अधीन कंपनियों द्वारा इन अनुदेशों के अनुपालन की निगरानी करने के लिए सक्षम प्राधिकारी होंगे और केंद्रीय सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र के उद्यमों द्वारा ऐसे अनुदेशों के अनुपालन की निगरानी के लिए भारत सरकार का लोक उद्यम विभाग सक्षम प्राधिकरण होगा।

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 2nd November, 2018

S.O. 5621(E).—In exercise of powers conferred by section 9 of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 (27 of 2006), the Central Government hereby issues the following instructions that all companies registered with the Companies Act, 2013 (18 of 2013) with a turnover of more than Rs. 500 crore (rupees five hundred crore) and all Central Public Sector Enterprises shall be required to get themselves onboarded on the Trade Receivables Discounting System platform, set up as per the notification of the Reserve Bank of India. The Registrar of Companies in each State shall be the competent authority to monitor the compliance of these instructions by companies under its jurisdiction and the Department of Public Enterprises, Government of India shall be the competent authority to monitor the compliance of such instructions by Central Public Sector Enterprises.

का.आ. 5622(अ).— सूक्ष्म, लघु और मध्यम उद्यम विकास अधिनियम की धारा 9 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, केंद्र सरकार एतद् द्वारा यह निदेश देती है कि वे सभी कंपनियां जो सूक्ष्म और लघु उद्यमों से वस्तुओं अथवा सेवाओं की आपूर्ति प्राप्त करती हैं और जिन्हें इस अधिनियम के प्रावधानों के अनुसार वस्तुओं अथवा सेवाओं की प्राप्ति अथवा आभासी प्राप्ति की तारीख से 45 दिनों से अधिक सूक्ष्म और लघु उद्यमों के आपूर्तिकर्ताओं को भुगतान नहीं हुआ है, वे निम्नलिखित को दर्शाते हुए, कारपोरेट कार्य मंत्रालय को एक छमाही रिटर्न प्रस्तुत करेंगे:

- (क) बकाया भुगतान की राशि; और
- (ख) विलंब के कारण।

New Delhi, the 2nd November, 2018

S.O. 5622(E).—In exercise of powers conferred by Section 9 of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, the Central Government hereby directs that all companies who get supplies of goods or services from micro and small enterprises and whose payments to micro and small enterprise suppliers exceed forty five days from the date of acceptance or the date of deemed acceptance of the goods or services as per the provisions of the Act, shall submit a half yearly return to the Ministry of Corporate Affairs stating the following:

- (a) The amount of payments due; and
- (b) The reasons of the delay.
